

TE MĀRA APARTMENTS - CASE STUDY

In 2016, the Wellington City Council demolished the dated Arlington apartments – a 57-unit 1970's complex in the inner-city suburb of Mount Cook to build a new set of apartments called 'Te Māra'.

The new and improved Te Māra Apartments would be a 105 unit and 300 bedroom apartment complex, comprising of 10 three storey buildings and 12 carparks. The challenge was to ensure the apartments had strong thermal performance, were energy efficient and sustainable. High acoustic performance was also essential to reduce external noises from the busy surrounding streets.

WHAT PRODUCTS WERE USED?
